The institute is offering the **two positions of Paramedic staff (Program Assistant II)** on contract basis, initially for a period of one year, with the possibility of extension based on the incumbent's satisfactory performance and the institute's requirements.

IIT Gandhinagar is a premier institute dedicated to excellence in education, research, and innovation. It is known for fostering an environment that encourages interdisciplinary learning, cutting-edge research, and the holistic development of students. As a Paramedic, one will have the opportunity to play a crucial role in supporting the health and well-being of the 3500+ campus community.

Key Responsibilities:

General:

- 1. Provide medical care and attend to patients at the Institute's Medical Centre.
- 2. Contribute to the Institute's outreach program and community health initiatives.
- 3. Attend emergency cases on a call basis beyond stipulated duty hours.
- 4. Collaborate with the campus healthcare team to ensure comprehensive medical support.

Patient Assessment:

- 5. Conducting a thorough physical examination.
- 6. Gathering information about the patient's medical history and current condition.
- 7. Prioritizing care based on the severity of the patient's condition.

Life Support:

8. Administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) if necessary.

Medical Interventions:

- 9. Administering medications and intravenous fluids.
- 10. Managing pain and providing other symptom relief measures.

Communication:

- 11. Effectively communicating with patients, bystanders, and other healthcare professionals.
- 12. Providing concise and accurate information to receiving hospital staff.

Transportation:

- 13. Safely transporting patients to medical facilities using ambulances or other appropriate vehicles.
- 14. Monitoring and maintaining the patient's condition during transport.

Documentation:

- 15. Recording and documenting all relevant patient information, interventions, and observations.
- 16. Maintaining accurate and complete medical records.

Required Qualifications:

Trained Paramedic/ Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) / 6 months courses nursing/ Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery (ANM)/ diploma in nursing assistant

Prior experience working in Emergency Rooms/Hospitals (for non-ex-services personnel)

Desirable:

Current or ex-services personnel (Army/Navy/Air-Force)

BSc (Nursing) from a recognized Institution/Board/University.

Additionally, candidates are expected to assist with tasks, including inventory management of the inhouse pharmacy, arising as part of running the medical center. Candidates with significant experience on this front are also encouraged to apply.

Age Limit: Up to 35 years, age bar for ex-services personnel (Army/Navy/Air-Force) is 60 years

Duration of Appointment: Initially for a period of one year, with the possibility of extension, based on the incumbent's performance and Institute's requirements.

Remuneration: A fixed remuneration ranging from Rs. 30,000/- to Rs. 55,000/- per month (based on qualifications and experiences).
