Minimum Eligibility Criteria for PhD Programmes in Maritime Engineering [Semester I, 2026-27]

Institute Eligibility Criteria

“Minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST/PwD) or 5.5 CPI (5.0 CPI for SC/ST/PwD) in postgraduate degree programme or in 4-years bachelor degree programme in appropriate branches”. Above\ mentioned eligibility criteria is minimum at Institute level. The department-wise eligibility criteria is given in the table below. The department may also use higher cut-off levels for shortlisting besides giving due consideration to the way questions are answered in the application form. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories would be eligible for relaxations, as per norms, in the selection criteria.

MARITIME ENGINEERING	BE/BTech/ME/MTech or equivalent degree in Civil Engineering, Structural Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Earth Sciences/ Remote Sensing, Mechanical Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Metallurgical and Material Engineering, Applied Mechanics, Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering, Engineering Design, Energy, Marine Engineering, Offshore structures, Ocean Engineering and allied branches.
