INSTITUTE HIGHLIGHTS



13TH CONVOCATION

IITGN hosted its 13th Convocation ceremony on June 29, 2024 at the Mahatma Mandir Convention & Exhibition Centre in Gandhinagar. The Institute conferred degrees to 530 students. Shri Rishad Premji, Executive Chairman of Wipro Limited, graced the occasion as chief guest. Shri Sanjiv Puri, Chairman, Board of Governors of IITGN, was also present during the occasion.

This year, 56 students were awarded various medals, including 40 gold medals and 17 silver medals for excellence in various categories such as academics, outstanding research, innovation, leadership, social service, sports, arts and culture, among others. Prior to the convocation, an Award Ceremony was held on June 28, 2024. During this event, 42 medalists received their medals. IITGN also conferred the Institute Fellow awards to Mr Mahesh R Patel, Former Principal, Vishwakarma Government Engineering College, and Mr Ruyintan Mehta, Former President, IITGN Foundation in the United States. The Institute Fellow Award honours individuals who have made significant and lasting contributions to the advancement of IITGN.

161% INCREASE IN CSR SUPPORT

In a significant milestone for the advancement of education, research, and community development, IITGN witnessed a remarkable 161% increase in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) support during FY 2023-24, as compared to FY 2022-23. SUPPORT FOR THE INSTITUTE

SUGUNAMMA AND SAROJAMMA SCHOL

ACTIVITIES AT IITGN

IITGN STUDENTS DEVELOP FULLY-AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE

A number of IITGN students developed a fully-functional autonomous vehicle that can operate without a driver. The vehicle was developed as part of a one-of-a-kind course on Autonomous Vehicles. The students transformed an electric golf cart into a state-of-the-art driverless vehicle capable of navigating the campus from the hostels to the academic area autonomously. The vehicle is equipped with hardware and software modifications to make it capable of fully-autonomous operations including lane detection, obstacle detection, automatic steering control, and automatic braking and acceleration.



SRIP 2024



The Summer Research Internship Programme (SRIP) kicked off at IITGN on May 5, 2024. The 14th edition of this eight-week flagship programme saw participation from talented students from various prestigious institutes across the country. The interns spent eight weeks at IITGN and carried out 134 research projects under the mentorship of IITGN faculty members. The interns concluded their internship with a poster presentation competition on July 9, 2024.

INVENTION FACTORY



IITGN hosted the fifth edition of Invention Factory, a unique programme in inventing. This intensive six-week long programme was held from May 27-July 5, 2024 at IITGN, June 3-July 12 at IIT Bombay, and from June 3-July 14 at IIT Jammu. The students from various IITs and NITs spent six-weeks to conceive, prototype, and pitch unique inventions to address various societal and consumer needs.

JEE OPEN HOUSE

IITGN hosted an online 'JEE Open House' for prospective BTech students and their parents on June 11, 2024. Institute authorities cleared the doubts of prospective students and provided first-hand guidance on campus life, admissions, programmes, career opportunities, and more.
