

Junior Research Fellow (JRF) Position for Mixed Method Study

Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar (IITGN) invites applications for the post of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) for a research project focused on social determinants of health. The candidate will be required to develop qualitative and quantitative data collection tools, collect data, analyze data, and write reports on the basis of conclusions drawn from the results of the analysis. The candidate should be willing to travel to field sites (rural or urban areas in different states of India) as a requirement of the project.

Essential Qualification: A master's degree in public health or any social science discipline with a minimum of

60% marks or equivalent CGPA in aggregate. Candidate should have a valid CSIR NET/UGC/GATE score or should have cleared any national level test conducted by IITs/IIMs. Candidates with prior experience in interviewing state and district level government officials will be preferred. Qualitative and quantitative data collection skills, familiarity with mixed-method study designs, as well as qualitative and quantitative data analysis are crucial.

Preferred Skills: Knowledge of social epidemiological theories, experience with qualitative interviews on sensitive topics as well as quantitative analysis of large datasets and excellent report-writing skills.

Duration: Initial appointment for one year

Remuneration: INR 31,000/month

1. Current CV with the list of publications
2. A one-page summary of previous research/work experience
