

Two-day tech summit concludes

Ahmedabad: Amalthea, the annual technological summit organized by IIT Gandhinagar (IIT-Gn) concluded on Sunday with a slew of talks, competitions, exhibition and hands-on workshops.

On day two, the speakers included Trishneet Arora, CEO of a tech security firm, interacted with the students about 'dark web' and perils of cyberspace. He talked about the most common cyber crimes and how to safeguard against them. Sivakumar S, head of industrial design at Royal Enfield, talked on theme of 'Integrating tradition and technology in design'. He emphasized on need for Modular-Renewable-Recyclable (MRM) for designing automobiles.

Ashish Deshpande, director of Re-Neu Robotics Lab at University of Texas, Austin, explained the audience about their robotic exoskeletons that helps persons with neurological disorders in moving their body parts freely.

The visitors also glimpsed humanoid robots, 3D printers, portable solar panels, advanced walking sticks for the blind and multi-purpose drones among other gizmos.
